

## 100 Basic Scripture Memory Verses

*Note: The selected verses are not, of course, intended to be exhaustive. Truly, it would be well if we could memorize all the verses of the Bible. These are selected to provide a sample and to encourage the discipline of memorizing God's Word. There are 50 verses from the Old Testament and 50 verses from the New Testament.*

### I. Old Testament

#### A. From the Torah (Law): Genesis-Deuteronomy

##### 1. Genesis 1:1

KJV Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

NKJV Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

##### 2. Genesis 1:27

KJV Genesis 1:27 So God created man in his *own* image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

NKJV Genesis 1:27 So God created man in His *own* image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

##### 3. Genesis 2:24

KJV Genesis 2:24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.

NKJV Genesis 2:24 Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.

##### 4. Genesis 3:15

KJV Genesis 3:15 And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

NKJV Genesis 3:15 And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel."

#### 5. Genesis 6:5

KJV Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man *was* great in the earth, and *that* every imagination of the thoughts of his heart *was* only evil continually.

NKJV Genesis 6:5 Then the LORD saw that the wickedness of man *was* great in the earth, and *that* every intent of the thoughts of his heart *was* only evil continually.

#### 6. Genesis 50:21

KJV Genesis 50:20 But as for you, ye thought evil against me; *but* God meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as *it is* this day, to save much people alive.

NKJV Genesis 50:20 "But as for you, you meant evil against me; *but* God meant it for good, in order to bring it about as *it is* this day, to save many people alive.

#### 7. Exodus 3:14

KJV Exodus 3:14 And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

NKJV Exodus 3:14 And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And He said, "Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.' "

#### 8. Leviticus 11:44a

KJV Leviticus 11:44 For I *am* the LORD your God: ye shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and ye shall be holy; for I *am* holy:

NKJV Leviticus 11:44 For I *am* the LORD your God. You shall therefore consecrate yourselves, and you shall be holy; for I *am* holy.

#### 9. Numbers 6:23-26

KJV Numbers 6:23 Speak unto Aaron and unto his sons, saying, On this wise ye shall bless the children of Israel, saying unto them, 24 The LORD bless thee, and keep thee: 25 The LORD make his face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee: 26 The LORD lift up his countenance upon thee, and give thee peace.

NKJV Numbers 6:23 "Speak to Aaron and his sons, saying, 'This is the way you shall bless the children of Israel. Say to them: 24 "The LORD bless you and keep you; 25 The LORD make His

face shine upon you, And be gracious to you; 26 The LORD lift up His countenance upon you, And give you peace." ' "

#### 10. Deuteronomy 6:4-5

KJV Deuteronomy 6:4 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God *is* one LORD: 5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

NKJV Deuteronomy 6:4 " Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD *is* one! 5 "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.

#### 11. Deuteronomy 30:19

KJV Deuteronomy 30:19 I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, *that* I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:

NKJV Deuteronomy 30:19 "I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, *that* I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live;"

### **B. From the Historical Books: Joshua-Esther**

#### 12. Joshua 24:15

#### 14. Ruth 1:16

KJV Ruth 1:16 And Ruth said, Intreat me not to leave thee, *or* to return from following after thee: for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people *shall be* my people, and thy God my God:

NKJV Ruth 1:16 But Ruth said: "Entreat me not to leave you, *Or to* turn back from following after you; For wherever you go, I will go; And wherever you lodge, I will lodge; Your people *shall be* my people, And your God, my God.

#### 15. 1 Samuel 15:22

KJV 1 Samuel 15:22 And Samuel said, Hath the LORD *as great* delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey *is* better than sacrifice, *and* to hearken than the fat of rams.

NKJV 1 Samuel 15:22 Then Samuel said: "Has the LORD *as great* delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, As in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey *is* better than sacrifice, *And* to heed than the fat of rams."

#### 16. 1 Samuel 17:45

KJV 1 Samuel 17:45 Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to thee in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast defied.

NKJV 1 Samuel 17:45 Then David said to the Philistine, "You come to me with a sword, with a spear, and with a javelin. But I come to you in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied.

#### 17. 2 Chronicles 7:14

KJV 2 Chronicles 7:14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

NKJV 2 Chronicles 7:14 if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

#### 18. Esther 4:14

KJV Esther 4:14 For if thou altogether holdest thy peace at this time, *then* shall there enlargement and deliverance arise to the Jews from another place; but thou and thy father's

house shall be destroyed: and who knoweth whether thou art come to the kingdom for *such* a time as this?

NKJV Esther 4:14 "For if you remain completely silent at this time, relief and deliverance will arise for the Jews from another place, but you and your father's house will perish. Yet who knows whether you have come to the kingdom for *such* a time as this?"

### C. From the Poetical Books: Job-Song of Solomon

#### 10. John 3:16

KJV John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

NKJV John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

#### 11. John 3:19

KJV John 3:19 And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

NKJV John 3:19 And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

#### 12. John 6:35

KJV John 6:35 And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

NKJV John 6:35 And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst."

#### 13. John 6:44

KJV John 6:44 No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.

NKJV John 6:44 No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day.

#### 14. John 8:12

KJV John 8:12 Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

NKJV John 8:12 Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."

## 15. John 10:11

KJV John 10:11 I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

NKJV John 10:11 I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep.

## 16. John 14:6

KJV John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

NKJV John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

## 17. John 14:1-2

KJV John 14:1 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. 2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if *it were* not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

NKJV John 14:1 Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. 2 In My Father's house are many mansions; if *it were* not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

## 18. John 15:5

KJV John 15:5 I am the vine, ye *are* the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.

NKJV John 15:5 "I am the vine, you *are* the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing."

## 19. John 17:17

**B. From Acts:**

## 20. Acts 2:38

KJV Acts 5:29 Then Peter and the *other* apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.

NKJV Acts 5:29 But Peter and the *other* apostles answered and said: "We ought to obey God rather than men."
